- Nancy's report Town of North Dansville Boards
 - The Town Board will advertise in the Hornell Spectator and is willing to advertise in the LCN if necessary.
 - They advertise all of their meetings as well as the Comprehensive Plan Work Group meetings in the Hornell Spectator in the beginning of the year.
 - CPWG will continue using Facebook (Quinn Golden), post in the Town Hall (Katie Infantino), free section of the Pennysaver and radio station (Marcia Miller).
 - Katie will post a memo on the bulletin board in the lobby of the town hall, unless otherwise notified.
 - Free Pennysaver ad only appears when there is space.
 - WDNY advertised the meetings everyday.
 - We will continue to personally contact people for their expertise.

- Schedule for the first six months in 2026
 - February - Safety: First responders including Fire, Police, Ambulance, Jr. Firefighters.
 - March - Education: Dansville Central School Superintendent, Library Director/Staff, GCC.
 - April - Health: Tri-County Family Medicine, UR Noyes, Livingston County Office of the Aging, YMCA.
 - May - Wellness: Noyes Mental Health, CASA, FoodLink, local food pantries.
 - June - Culture: local festival organizers (WITV, Rally 'Round the Valley, 2nd Saturday, Dogwood Festival), Mural Committee (Salome), Genesee Valley Council on the Arts, Chamber Events Committee
 - July - Religion: Pastors and Priests from each church.
 - August - We will have another reorganizational meeting to discuss the next few months.
- Ann Lafford will send me the name for the head of the Office of the Aging. She will also get me the information for the YMCA (Christof).
- We will work on Economic Development after the first 6 months. We will invite Bill Bacon from the county. Livingston County is considering putting something at Exit 4 on 390. We would also like to hear from the Chamber of Commerce.
- When inviting people to speak to the CPWG:
 - Overview of what the person/group does.
 - What goals do you have?
 - What new plans or activities?
- We still have infrastructure to discuss.
- Nancy has information from years ago regarding infrastructure that we can review.
- Green energy needs a section in the new plan.

Misc Discussion

- When we write the plan, Ann Lafford suggested we have an individual attached to an action. Someone who will be responsible for that action. This will come under the Administration section.
- Under the Administration section we could include things like:
 - Training for all Town and Village Board members, ZBA, and the Planning Board.
 - The Boards need to read the Comprehensive Plan.
 - Anyone running for a seat on a board should read the Comprehensive Plan.
 - Anyone running for a seat on a board should attend board meetings well before the election.
- Charlie Perkins would like to work with Sue Demuth on sidewalks. The priority needs to be on streets that are the most dangerous.
- Sue said we are writing a hopeful version of the Comprehensive Plan.
- Some grants may not be attainable, but other groups or organizations may be willing to contribute.
- Nancy said the binders with the sidewalk survey have been lost/misplaced. She brought them back to the village but they could not locate them.
